Dignity in Care conference Putting Dignity at the Heart

On 4 December Healthwatch Redbridge held their Dignity in Care conference. Over 50 people attended the event.

The conference was used to launch our Enter & View reports based on visits to care homes and hospital wards in and around the borough.

The aim of the visits was to identify and report on good practice in regards to dignity and respect and to highlight opportunities where improvements might benefit people who use specific services. In total, eight care homes and two hospital wards were visited by our representatives.

The conference also raised awareness in regards to Dignity Action Day 2016 and highlight the importance of dignity and respect in care.



The majority of reports were positive with a number of homes showing good practices of Dignity.

One home made a 'dignity tree' whilst another offered joint resident and staff dignity training. However, there were some room for improvement. Some staff seemed to be rushed meaning they appeared to have a shortage of time to do the 'little things' that matter to those in a health or social care setting. There were also delays in addressing/implementing identified concerns and changes required.

Celebrate Dignity Action Day 2016

Dignity Action Day 2016 is on the 1st of February and is dedicated to making sure that people who use health and care services are treated as individuals and to remind others of the little things the can uphold a person's dignity.

Here are some of the ways you can take part in Dignity Action Day 2016.

- Inviting staff and services uses to create a 'dignitree' like the one pictured. The tree can be made from paper and people can write on the leaves about what dignity means to them or how it can be improved/insured in the environment that they work/live in.
- Hold a 'Digni-Tea party'. like the one we're having. You could invite carers and residents to come together and sit down and talk whilst offering teas, coffees and cakes.
- Hold an event where there are stalls where different people teach others a skill. For example, the older generation could teach younger people how to knit, whilst the young people teach the older generation how to use social media.

A Dignity Champion is someone who is passionate about the idea that dignity is a basic human right.
